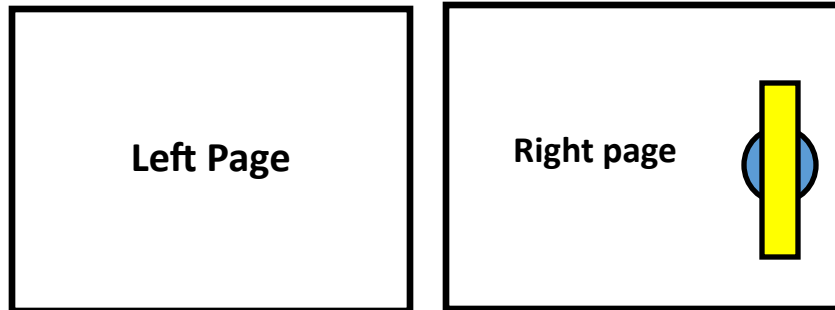


How to Line Up Magnets in a Mini Book

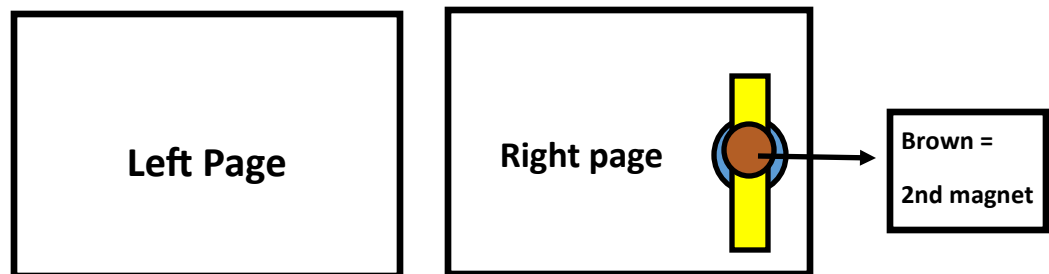
Take one magnet and place it where you want it on one page only.

Glue in place with a dot of wet glue.

And then place a piece of double sided tape over the magnet

BUT do not remove the top covering on the tape (yet).

The illustration above shows the magnet (in blue) and the tape (in yellow)



Take a second magnet and **NO GLUE** and place it on top of the existing magnet.

This will tell you whether you have the positive or negative side.

If the magnet "sticks" you're good to go.

While the second magnet is sitting on top of the first magnet, place a tiny dot of wet glue on top of the second magnet. Then immediately close the right page to the left page.

One of two things will happen (depending on your wet glue): (1) Either the magnet will stick to the left page (and that's good) OR (2) the second magnet will leave a glue mark on the left page (and that's good too).

By following the glue mark on the left page, you know where to glue your second magnet on the left page.

And your magnets will work perfectly!

Remove the tape on the original magnet and you're ready to decorate your page over the magnets.
